

Information about the Swedish ESF Council's processing of individuals' personal data in connection with cases concerning support

This form must be handed out to employees and participants in projects which, following a decision by the Swedish ESF Council, are financed by the European Social Fund.

The Swedish ESF Council is responsible for personal data and processes personal data with the support of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The purpose of the regulation is, among other things, to protect private individuals so that their personal integrity is not violated when personal data is processed. The Swedish ESF Council therefore wishes to provide the following information.

Personal data is all kinds of information that can be directly or indirectly attributed to a living natural person.

Personal data that is already processed and may be processed by the project owner or any cooperating party, may also be processed by the Swedish ESF Council as part of our exercise of authority or as part of the fulfillment of a public interest, for the purposes of support management, control, statistics, information and for follow-up, evaluation and analysis.

The information is processed both electronically and through obtained documents. The Swedish ESF Council also provides the information to other authorities and to the EU institutions for similar purposes, in accordance with what follows from EU legislation or national regulations. The Swedish ESF Council will store the information in accordance with what applies to authorities' archive management and other applicable EU legislation and national regulations.

Contact the Swedish ESF Council if you want access to the personal data we process about you. You have the right to access this information. You also have the right to object to the processing of the data, request correction and request a restriction on how the data is used and to have the data deleted. According to the GDPR, the right to restriction and deletion upon request is limited and is examined in each individual case.
